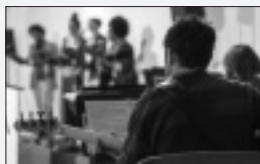

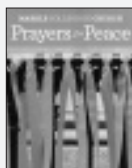

Rev. Kirsty DePree reflects on Marble's Congregational Care, something your gifts all help make possible!

"Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." — Matthew 25:40

This is one of my favorite passages. It is a reminder to see Christ in "the least of these." It is a passage that calls us to look at what it means to be part of God's Kingdom – a place where the poor are royalty, the sick are cared for, the stranger welcomed, the least of these are blessed. I have come to realize the least of these is not just a handful of people; no it is the majority, for every follower of God has at one time or another known pain, suffering, sadness, fear, hunger, imprisonment or illness.



On any given day at Marble I get an up close look at the Kingdom of God in action. I get to see the people of God show compassion and it happens in numerous ways. When someone says "I am hungry", through the generous contribution of Marble Fights Hunger, we are able to send them out with food. When someone who is thirsty comes in we are quick to give a drink of water or if it is a cold day, Judy Tulin, my assistant, makes a great cup of coffee. Visitors and members alike searching for prayer come in on a daily basis and use our Prayer Room finding peace and comfort. We clothe the naked, just last week someone was almost naked in the freezing cold and we were able to clothe her with a warm coat and clothes. On a weekly basis I visit and pray with the sick and I get to hear the stories of Stephen Ministers who provide hope and healing. We have a congregant who is imprisoned and we have someone who prays and writes him often. I could go on and on about the way we show compassion and love at Marble. It isn't always glamorous, but necessary as we show the love of Christ to the least of these at any given moment.

The joy of the Lord is my strength and my joy and the joy of so many people at Marble is powerfully realized when we have seen Christ in the least of these and have been part of turning their pain into joy.



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) about Annual Giving

What is a pledge?

A pledge is a promise to give financially to support Marble's Mission and Ministries. Giving is both a spiritual commitment and an act of worship. It is not binding, but rather a conversation with God about what you can pledge to our shared ministry. As a way of making a pledge to God and each other, we dedicate our pledge cards (our written promises) in Worship today, Sunday, November 19.

How do I make a pledge?

You can pledge by filling out a pledge card (found in pew racks and the Marble Loft) or at MarbleChurch.org (click on "Give" on top of homepage and "2018 Pledge Form"). You can "give as you go" via offering envelopes or even set up a monthly recurring credit card or auto-check contribution. I've pledged in the past. Do I need to do it again?

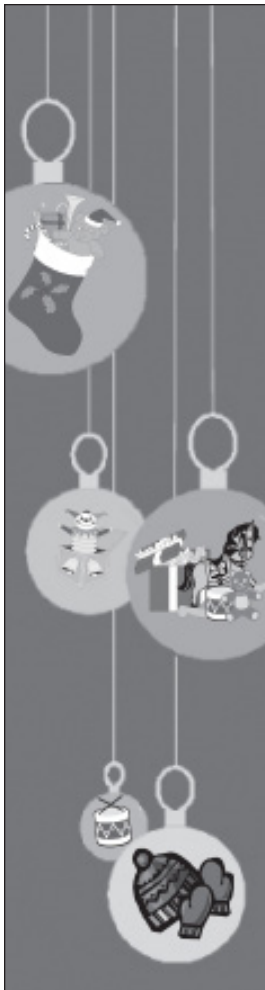
